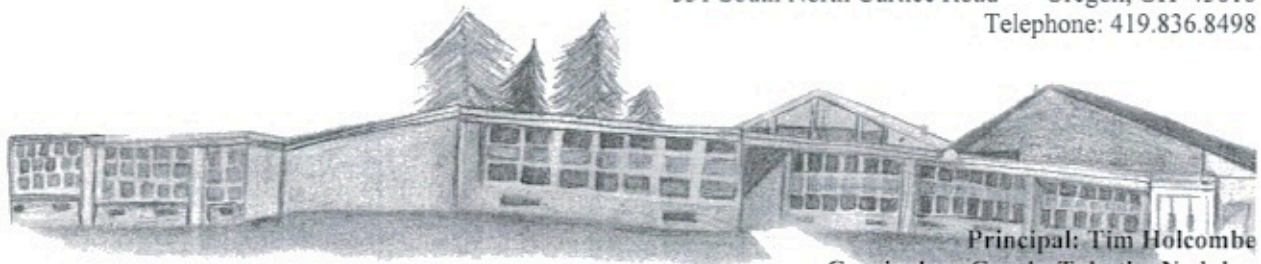

Dear Parents of Incoming 5th Grade Eisenhower Students:

We are very much looking forward to welcoming your family to the Eisenhower experience. We have worked very hard to make Eisenhower a great place for learning and we are excited to share that with you.

We want to share several important events and dates with you as we move into summer break:

- On-line student re-registration
 - Please see the attached flier on student re-registration
 - Registration begins on July 23rd
 - You will be able to create or up-date accounts, pay fees, and put money on your child's lunch account
 - Please remember that you must be re-registered prior to the Eisenhower Open House
- Final schedules will be available on Power School beginning August 1st
 - Please note that any version seen prior to August 1st is not the final version
- Schedule Pick-up / Open House
 - Wednesday, August 18th from 11:00 am—6:00 pm
 - We will be combining two important events this year. You will be able to come and spend approximately 30-60 minutes to accomplish the following:
 - Pick-up your student's schedule with his/her locker number on it
 - Pick-up student agenda (with handbook inside) and parent folder
 - Pick-up your student's t-shirt, compliments of the Eisenhower Parents for Students and Staff Organization
 - Students are encouraged to bring their school supplies and put them in their assigned locker
 - Families can walk the building and meet teachers and some staff members
 - Innovations will be present for school pictures in the gymnasium
 - Vision and hearing checks occur in the 5th grade and Nurse Batch will be conducting those if you have time to do so. If not, students will be seen during the year
 - Registration and fee payment must have taken place before Open House
 - If you are unable to attend, we will get the pertinent items and information to your student once school starts
 - We will not be collecting fees at Schedule Pick-up/Open House and will not be available to help with registration

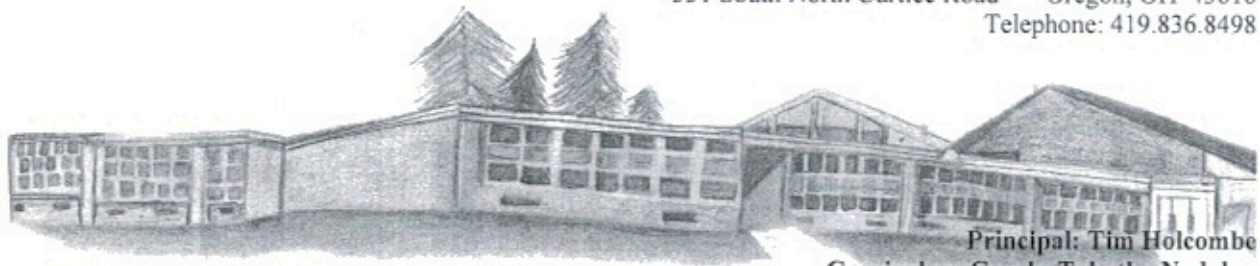

- 1st Day of School for 5th Graders– “Learning to Fly Day”
 - **Friday, August 20th our 5th grade students** will have “Learning to Fly Day” as they become Eagles of Eisenhower. They will begin their day in their Travelling Group class, transition to the auditorium, then transition to the gym for activities welcoming them to Ike before breaking into small groups for orientation and lunch. They will then be guided by their Travelling Group teacher through the remainder of the day.
 - This day will be a welcoming experience for your child. Sixth graders will be starting on the 19th and then have the day off on the 20th, so all staff members will be available for our 5th graders
- 1st Day for Entire Student Body
 - Monday, August 23rd will see the 5th and 6th graders have their first day together

The link will take you to the 2020—2021 handbook, but we anticipate the 2021—2022 policies to be very similar.

Your student will not need to purchase locks for the 2021—2022 school year as we do not anticipate using them on lockers or in the locker room. More information will be forthcoming on those procedures.

5th Grade Supply
2021-22

- Book bag (no wheels)
*note: book bags will be carried to classes, should be a manageable size
- Folders: 5 durable 2-pocket with holes
*Label: Math, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts, Academic Practice
- Index Cards: 1 pack 3"x 5"
- 3 spiral notebooks: 1 one-subject, wide ruled, Label: Math, Science/Social Studies, Language Arts
- Post-it Notes- 1 small pack
- Dry erase markers: 4 black (thick)
- Earbuds or headphones: inexpensive, put in a plastic Ziploc bag, label with name
- Supply bag (no boxes)
*A soft lunch bag with a handle works well
Put these supplies in the bag:
 - Pencils: 24
 - Pens: 5 black or blue
 - Eraser: 1 large
 - Scissors
 - Glue sticks: 1 large or 3 small
 - Markers: 1 10-pack OR Colored pencils: 1 12-pack

All students: 1 box of tissues

Last Name: A-L 1 container of sanitizing wipes

Last Name: K-Z 1 bottle of hand sanitizer, 10oz or larger

Additional items for 5th grade students attending 6th grade Math class:

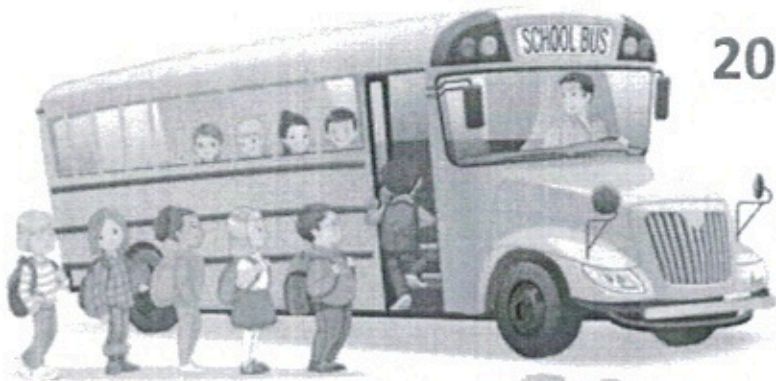
- 1-inch RED 3-ring binder
- 5 divider tabs for binder

Additional items for 5th grade students attending Ms. Stanton's Gifted Language Arts Class:

- 1-inch 3-ring binder
- 5 divider tabs for 5 for binder
- Scrapbook (size 12x12 with 10 total pages)

*Students will not need locks for lockers this school year.

*For Physical Education this year, wear athletic shoes/clothes on PE days so you are prepared for physical activity. Students will be allowed to change into shorts if needed, but must remove hoodies during PE class.



2021-2022 *Re-Registration* for Returning Students

Student re-registration will open July 23, and end August 2. All returning students entering grades 1-12 need to be re-registered for the 2021-22 school year. As in the past, you will need to log into your PowerSchool Parent Portal to complete this process. Please make sure you are able to log into avoid complications in July. If you are unable to login to your portal, or haven't created one yet, please contact Linda Toth By June 28 (parent portals will be disabled from June 29 – July 22) at 419-693-0661 x3273 or send an e-mail to PowerSchoolParentPortal@oregoncs.org to request assistance.

The re-registration process will be the same as in past years.
