


Camp Michindoh Important Upcoming Dates-2021

November 19th - Final late camp payment of \$235 due


November 29th through December 3rd, 2021 – Camp Michindoh trip for students



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- How are Cabin Leaders selected? The cabin leaders are selected by a school representative and all screening is
 done by the school.
- How are cabins assigned? Cabins are assigned by the teachers and they typically make sure that your child is
 with at least one of their friends.
- Do girls and boys stay in the same area? No. The cabins are spaced out with a small grass area between them
 and we try our best to make sure that space is always respected.
- Is there security that patrols the area at night? There are 10 resident families that live in different areas of the
 camp. If someone comes onto the grounds who is not recognized by any of those families, the men go and check
 out who they are and take appropriate action. The Outdoor Education School staff also live on the grounds and help
 maintain security on the grounds.
- What kind of down time do the campers have? We fill their day and allow for very little down time. After supper is the only time that the campers have some time just to hang out in their cabins or play a game as a small group. The general rule is that if the camper is not with an adult, they are in the wrong place.
- What types of meals are served? Our meals are served with 6th graders in mind. The teachers have been given
 a list of example meals served which they can share with you. There is cereal at every breakfast and a fruit and
 salad bar at lunch and dinner.
- What if my child does not like what is being served or is a vegetarian? If your child does not like what we
 are eating we will find something for them such as peanut butter and jelly. If your child is a vegetarian, please make
 sure that the teachers let us know and we will be sure to have vegetarian options for them.
- What is the best way to label their belongings? The best thing to do is to write on the tag of clothing with a permanent marker. For other items such as a camera or flashlight, please write your child's name with a permanent marker on an area that is visible. If they pack their sleeping bag/blankets in a plastic garbage bag, make sure that it is clearly labeled and/or decorated so they can locate it easily. Pack an extra garbage bag for them to put their sleeping bag/blankets into for the trip home since the first one usually gets torn on the first day.
- What does a typical day look like? The campers wake up around 6:30 a.m. and get ready for the day. They also have to clean their cabins before flag raising at 7:30 a.m. They eat breakfast and then go to two classes before lunch. After lunch at 11:45 a.m. they go to two more classes. After the second class in the afternoon, the campers have afternoon activity time where they pick from a variety of activities lead by the staff. Dinner is served at 5:15 p.m. followed by an evening program. Evening programs may include a campfire, relay races, night hikes, skit night, and a square dance. They go back to the cabins at 9:00 p.m. to get ready for bed and lights out is at 10:00 p.m. The Michindoh staff roam the cabin area around that time to make sure that everything is dark and quiet for the night.
- What types of classes will they be going to? The classes are not typical school classes. Teachers pick the
 classes from a variety of science-based and team-building class options. Some of the most commonly picked classes
 are reptiles and amphibians, aquatic life, Journey through Time (a team building class), ecosystems, outdoor living
 skills, wild mammals, and birds.
- When will my child go to camp? November 29th December 3rd
- What is the cost? \$215 by the turn-in date and \$235 by late date
