

REPORT ON BULLYING INCIDENTS
 1st Semester 2017-18 School Year
 (August 14, 2017 – December 20, 2017)

School regulations in Ohio require that the superintendent prepare a report to the school board on a semi-annual basis of all reported incidents of bullying and post the report on the district web site. Under the law, bullying is defined as “an intentional written, verbal or physical act that a student has exhibited toward another particular student more than once and the behavior causes both mental or physical harm to the other student and is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening or abusive educational environment for the other student.”

These are the reports received from each school building in the district for the first semester of the 2017-18 school year.
