Sophomore Career Day – is going VIRTUAL!!!

The Clay High School Career Tech (CT) department will be hosting a Career Tech Virtual Expo for all 10th grade students and parents on Wednesday, January 13, 2021, beginning at 12:00 pm.

The first step is to **CREATE** your plan by visiting the Career Tech website <https://www.oregoncityschool.org/CareerTechnology.aspx> to explore all Career Tech opportunities CHS has to offer.

Once you visit the Career Tech website, **DISCOVER** your options by registering for virtual session(s) with our instructors to learn about one or more of our CT Programs during the Career Tech Virtual Expo. Click on the “Register for Career Expo” link under each program on the website to register by January 8, 2021. An email confirming registration with the Zoom link to attend the virtual sessions during the Expo on January 13, 2021, will be sent to registered attendees. Session recordings will be made available following the Expo on the CT website.

LIVE your future after the Expo by applying to our CT Programs! Students will receive an email with steps on how to apply to a Career Tech program after the Expo. Students will have until January 15, 2021, to select and apply to their top three programs.

2nd Semester Remote Instruction

Selective Service Registration

Parents, did you know it is law that all men must register with the Selective Service within 30 days of their 18th birthday? To help men register, they only need to go to SSS.gov. Men can preregister at 17 years and 3 months of age and their registration will be held until they reach the age of 18. Men who fail to register are unable to receive federally funded college loans and grants; are unable to get into federally funded training and certification programs; and are barred from all federal employment and ineligible from many state and local government jobs. Registration is not only a legal requirement, but a civic duty and key component of the national defense readiness.
