2021 Ohio State Test (OST) Schedule

All Clay students enrolled in the classes listed below will be taking the Ohio State Tests this spring (dates indicated below). Our students will be completing all tests online for the spring testing schedule.

Biology (regular, honors & retakes) = April 15

American History (regular, honors, AP & retakes) = April 16

Government (regular, honors, AP & retakes) = April 16

Algebra I and Geometry (regular, honors & retakes) = April 29 and April 30

Clay High School will operate on a 2-hour delay schedule on all the dates indicated above. Only those students scheduled to take a test will be required to start school at 7:50 a.m. All other students not taking the test will begin school at 9:50 a.m. Dismissal on testing days will remain at 2:35 p.m. Morning bus transportation will be provided for both the 7:50 and 9:50 start times.
