College Credit Plus Informational Meeting

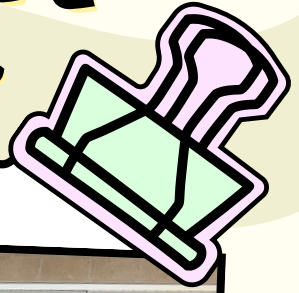

State Aquariums

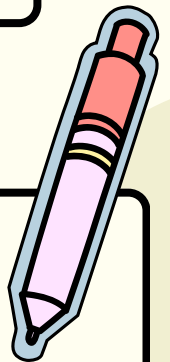

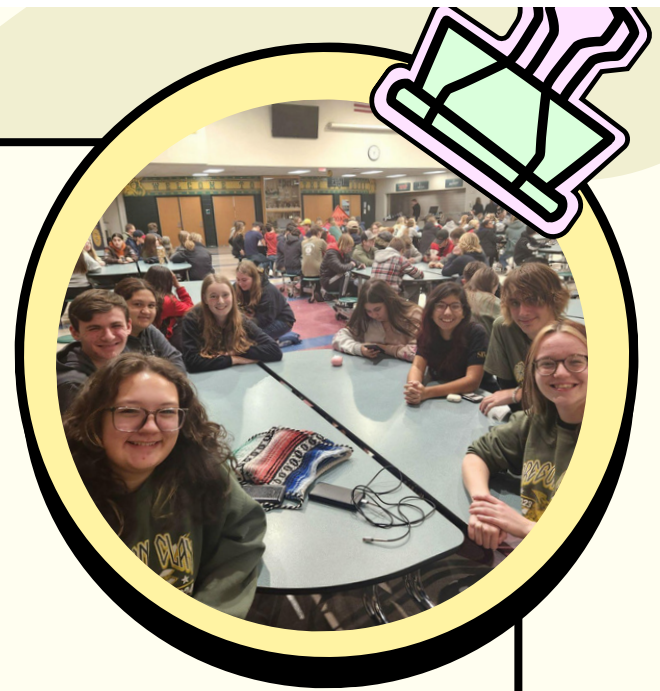
WELLNESS DAY

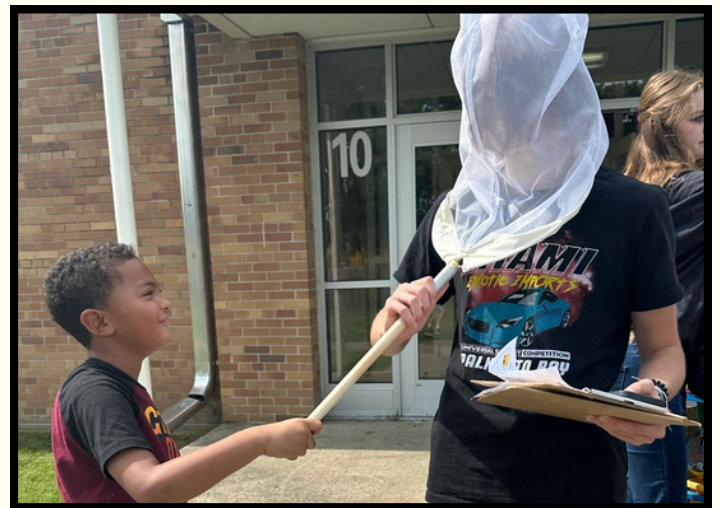

Senior Field Trips



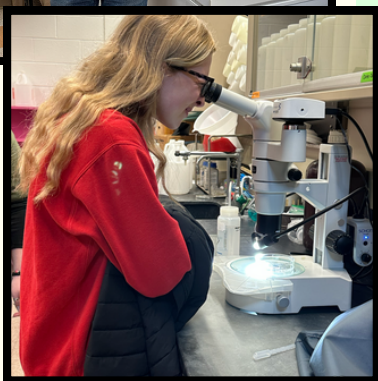
Oregon Wastewater Facility

To start off our water quality unit, the seniors traveled to the wastewater treatment plant. They were educated on the process of treating water and what happens before it can be filtered in the lake. This was just the first of three field trips that the seniors took to learn about our drinking water. They were able to see the aeration tanks, the bar screens that remove the sludge, the underground operations and piping of the facility and learn about what education is needed to run a plant.
