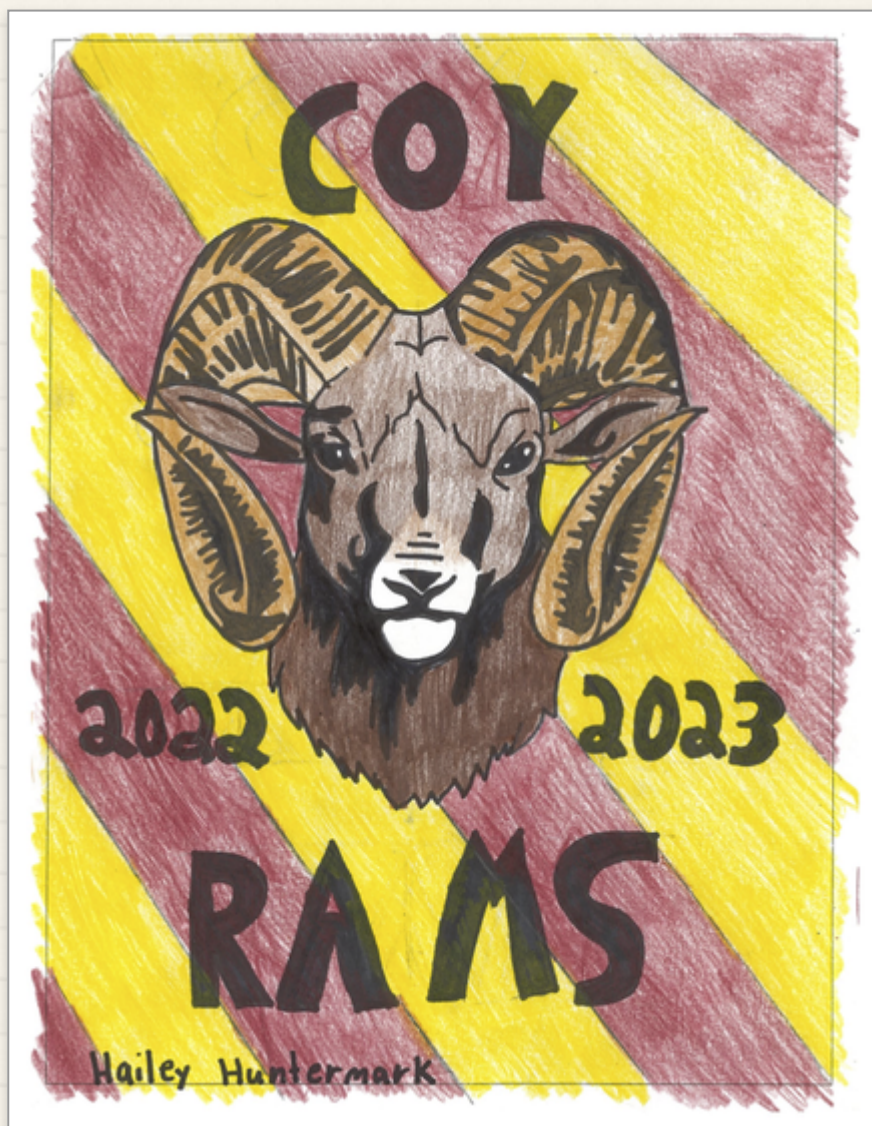

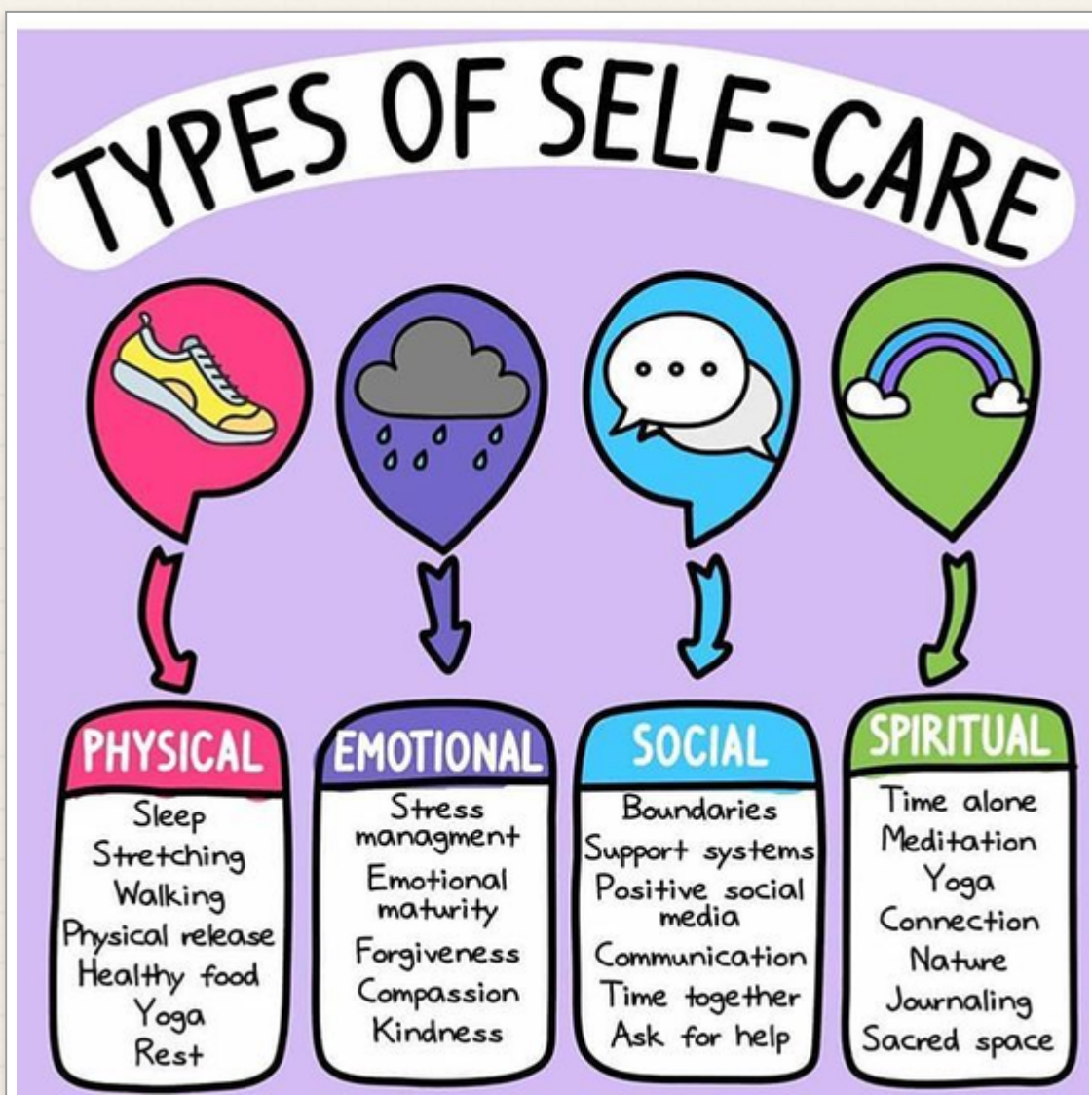
## WINTER COATS, SHOES AND BOOTS AVAILABLE

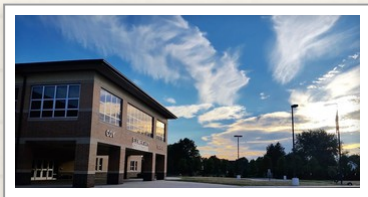
