LAST WEEK OF OHIO STATE TESTING!

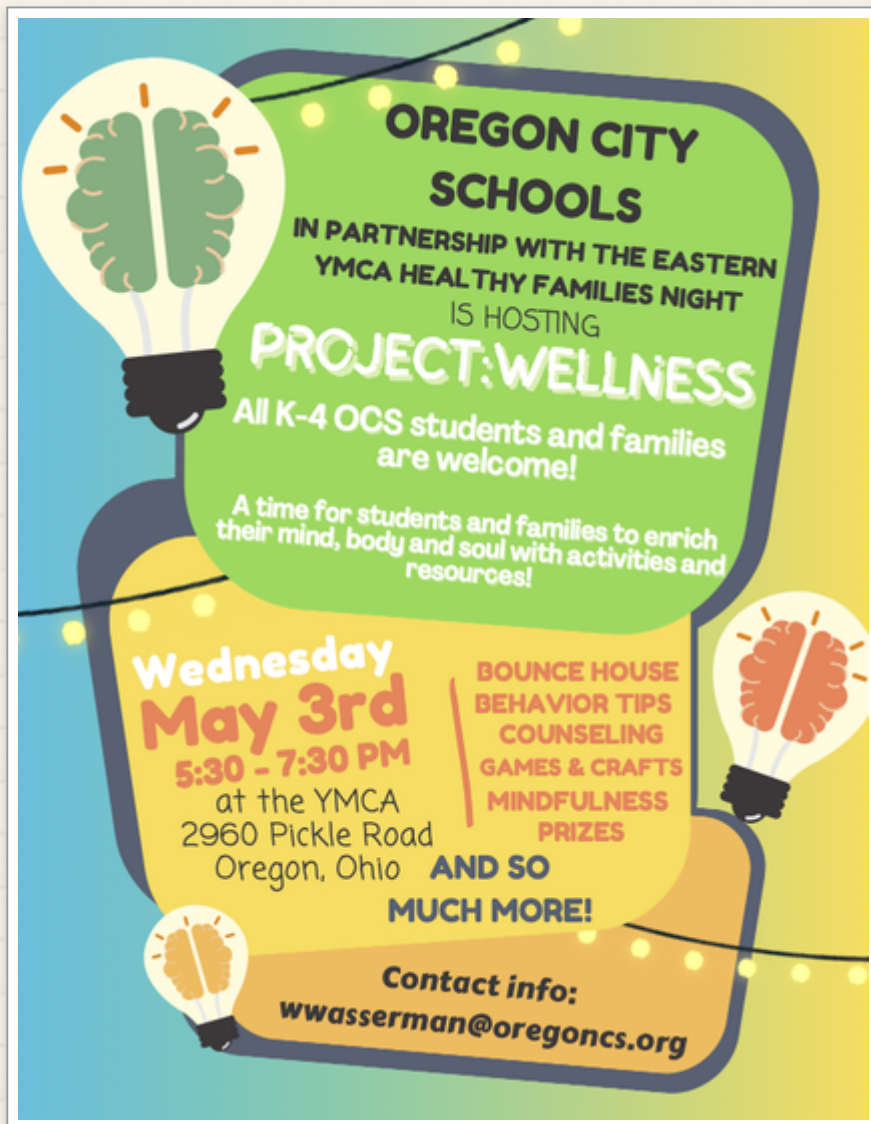

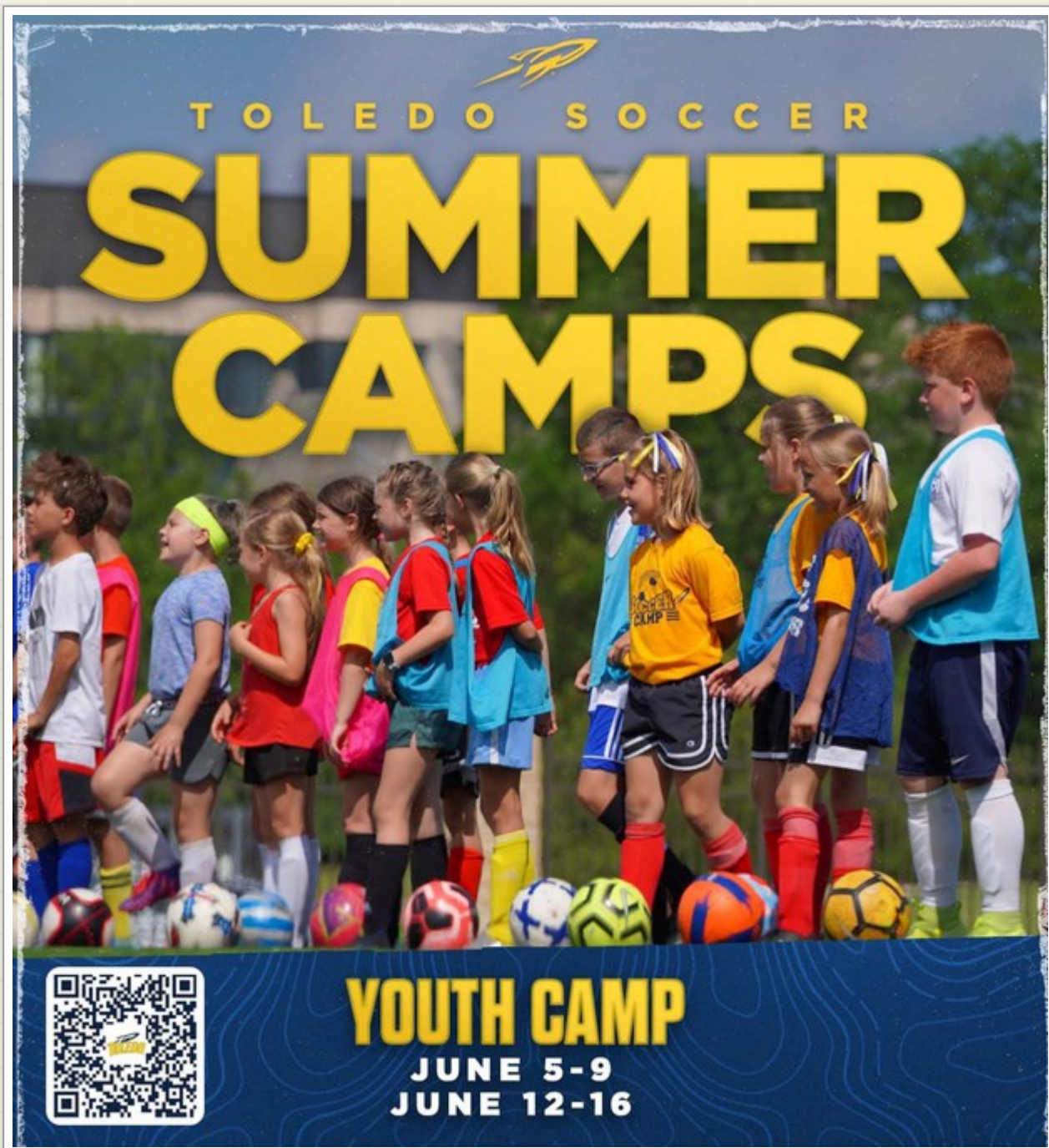
