2022-2023 Registration for Returning Students



Student registration will open July 22, and end August 1. All returning students entering grades 1-12 need to have registration submitted for the 2022-23 school year. As in the past, you will need to log into your PowerSchool Parent Portal to complete this process. Please make sure you are able to login to avoid complications and frustration in July. If you are unable to login to your portal, or haven't created one yet, please contact Linda Toth by June 23 (parent portals will be disabled from June 30 – July 21) at 419-693-0661 x3273 or send an e-mail to PowerSchoolParentPortal@oregoncs.org to request assistance.

The registration process will be the same as in past years. If you need assistance to complete the process, directions will be posted to the Oregon City Schools (OCS) website at www.oregoncityschools.org. Additional information and reminders will be sent out via e-mail and posted to the OCS website as we approach the July 22 launch.
