Dear 2nd and 4th Grade families,

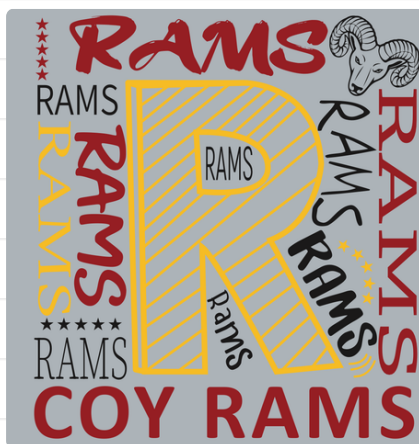

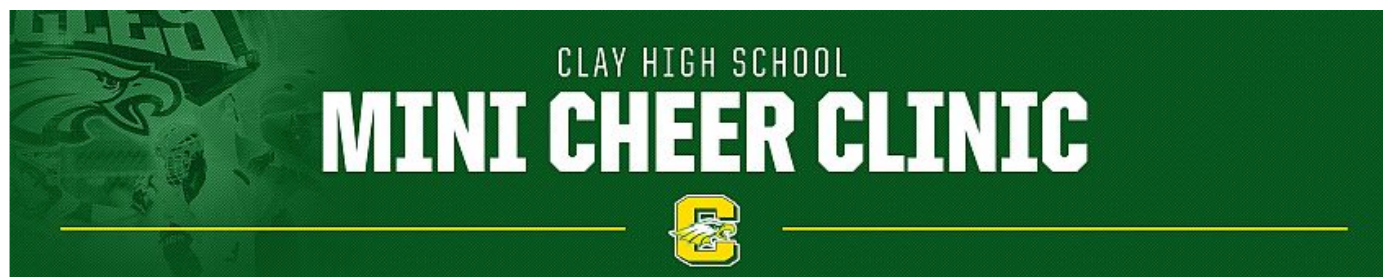
