Just some friendly reminders...

- Please note that open toed shoes, spaghetti strap shirts and shorts that are too short do not follow our dress code. Please make sure that your child's clothing attire is appropriate and meets the guidelines of our school dress code. If you have dress code questions, please reference the Coy handbook link at the top of this newsletter.
- If dropping your child off in the morning, please make sure to pull-up as directed so that we can keep the flow of traffic moving.
- We do not have staff on supervision duty until 8:45 for those students eating breakfast at school. If you drop your children off in the morning and your children are not eating breakfast at school, please plan to drop-off at 8:50. The tardy bell rings at 9:05.
- For safety reasons, we do not allow parents/guardians to walk their children to the classrooms in the morning. Should you need to come into the building at any time, for any reason, you must first report to the office.
- Make sure to always be aware of the possibility of inclement weather. No one is on supervision duty during two-hour delays until 10:35AM. Drop-off time during two-hour delays is 10:35 for breakfast and 10:50 for those not eating breakfast. The tardy bell rings at 11:05 during two-hour delays.
- Parent pick-up doors open at 3:35. Please be prompt in picking up your child as we have supervision on duty until 3:50. When picking your child up from parent pick-up, please come in the left cafeteria door and exit the right café door so that we can keep the flow of traffic moving.
- If your child's after school route changes, he/she **must** have a note for the teacher otherwise your child will be sent home on their normal route. If changing your child's route home, please notify the office before 3:00 P.M. We cannot guarantee that messages will get to classrooms if not notified by 3:00 P.M.

Nurse News...

Please be aware that all kindergartners (and new students to Oregon school district) must be up-to-date on immunizations within 10 days of them entering school.

No longer are you able to have a date set to get shots for your child unless it is within 10 days of beginning school or have recently had an immunization to catch up. If this has happened they can't receive immunizations for 6 months. That will be considered "In progress".

Anyone not completing shots or have them updated within 10 days of school beginning will be EXCLUDED!! No exceptions. Please contact Nurse Ward-Ziegler with questions 419-693-0624.
