Important Information for Auditions

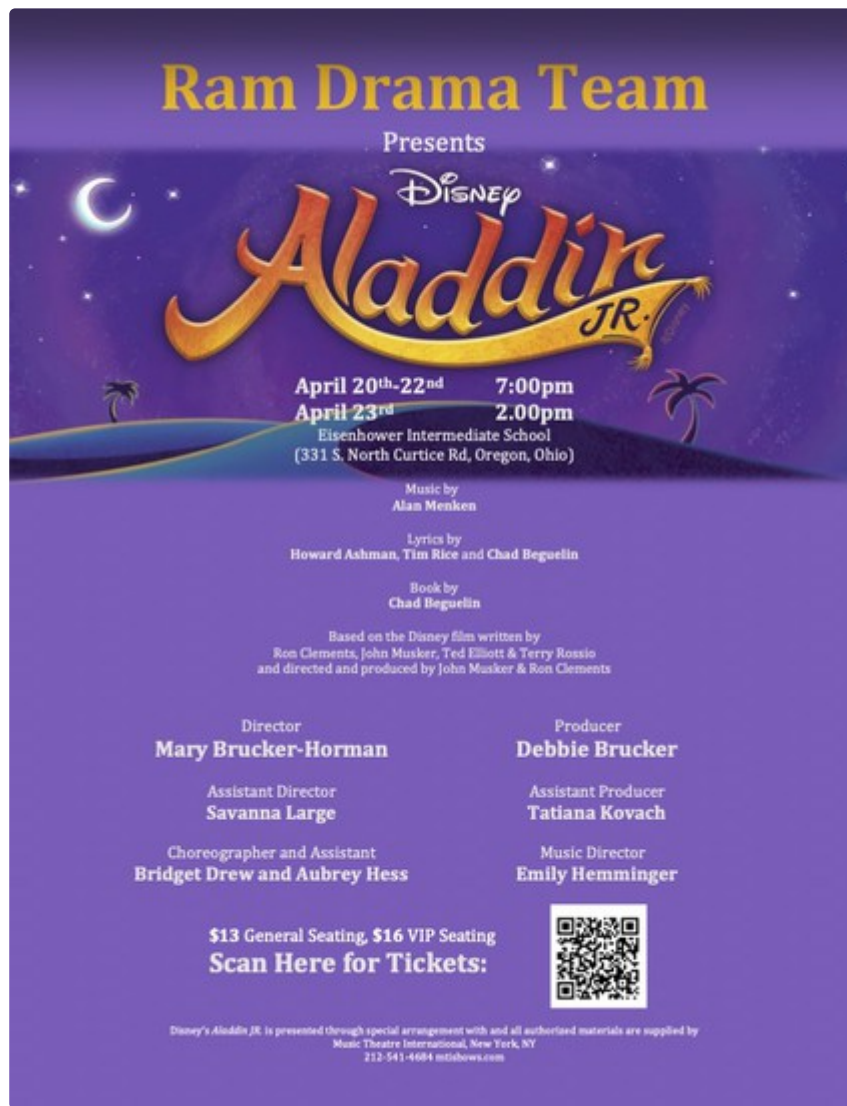
- All different acts encouraged: singing, dancing, gymnastics, magic, skits, etc.
