News from Our School Nurse

The State of Ohio requires all incoming seventh graders to have **1 Meningococcal vaccine and the TDap booster in order to attend school in the Fall of 2023**. Consult with your healthcare provider to see if your child needs these immunizations. These immunizations are also available at the **Mercy Health Center at OCS 419-696-5533**.

Please bring written proof of immunizations to your child's current school or with you to the 7th grade Fassett orientation in August 2023. No student will be allowed to start 7th grade without showing proof of receiving these immunizations. If you have any questions please call Nurse Bridget at 419-836-8498.

100 fifth grade students participated in an exciting Math Night on Thursday, April 20 from 2:40-6:00. The event was designed to help students gain confidence in their math skills in preparation for the upcoming state math test.

The evening opened in the auditorium where students enjoyed a snack and social time with friends. Students then rotated with their groups through six different math stations and one "brain break" station. Each of the math stations focused on a different state standard.

In Mrs. Meterko's room, students played a board game that covered decimal patterns and powers of 10. Fractions were reviewed by Mr. Haar and Mrs. Wilkins with games of Connect 4 and Jeopardy. In Mrs. Gau's room, students brushed up on rounding and comparing decimals while students in Mrs. Neuman's room participated in a decimal operations scavenger hunt.

Finally, Mr. Meyer had the students competing in a game of Kahoot to solve volume problems. The beautiful weather allowed us to get the students outside for a few minutes as well. Miss Koopman and Mrs. Gernheuser supervised various outside games, including Gaga Ball and running races.

The end of the night brought a pizza party and an atmosphere of great enthusiasm and excitement. The students' enjoyment of the night was evident through the many smiles and laughs that were shared.
