## **News from Our School Nurse**

The State of Ohio requires all incoming seventh graders to have 1 Meningococcal vaccine and the TDap booster in order to attend school in the Fall of 2023. Consult with your healthcare provider to see if your child needs these immunizations. These immunizations are also available at the Mercy Health Center at OCS 419-696-5533.

Please bring written proof of immunizations to your child's current school or with you to the 7th grade Fassett orientation in August 2023. No student will be allowed to start 7th grade without showing proof of receiving these immunizations. If you have any questions please call Nurse Bridget at 419-836-8498.


