The Eagle Way Lives at Eisenhower!

The Eagle Way is the set of expectations we have for daily behavior that is taught and lived throughout the halls at Eisenhower.

The Eagle Way is based on the concepts of "Work Hard", which ties to the character trait of responsibility, and "Treat People Right", which ties to the character trait of respect. Our students are taught what these things look like in each part of our building. The matrix can be found in your Student/Parent Handbook.

The Eagle Way is a proactive approach that recognizes student successes and reinforces desired behaviors, which aids in improving school safety and promoting positive behavior. This occurs in the form of "acknowledgements". These acknowledgments are given to students in many ways, but one being through the use of Talon Tickets. Talon Tickets are given to students daily who are exhibiting qualities that we want to reinforce.

Talon Tickets are collected each morning and on Fridays, two tickets are pulled from the bucket in which they are collected all week.

On Friday, September 1st, we began our process of selecting Talon Tickets from the buckets in each Traveling Group. Those whose names are pulled are able to pick off our prize cart, their names are put on placards which are displayed in the hallway for the week, and their names are announced on the morning announcements and their names will be published in the Fly-er.

We announce days to our students on the morning announcements.

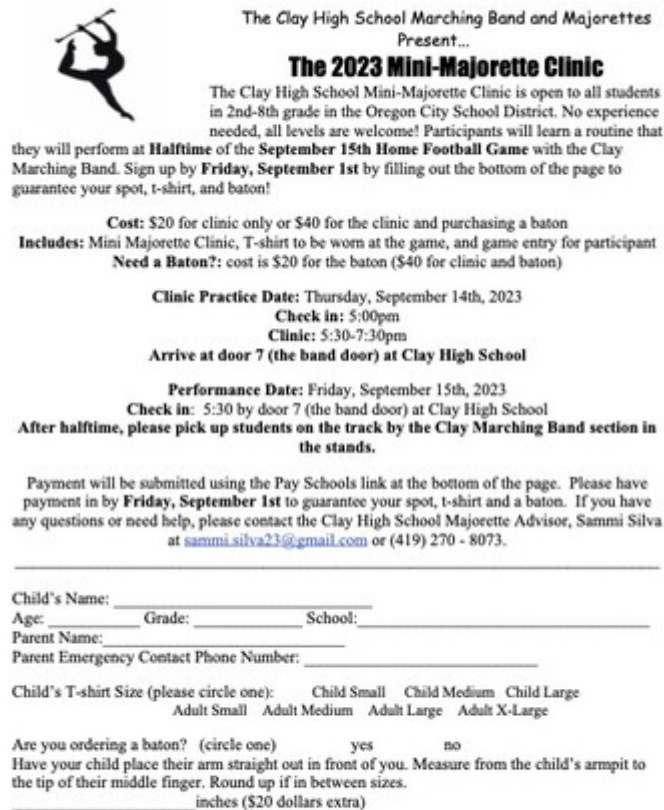

What is Academic Practice?

Students today understand what it means to practice. Many of our students are involved in music, sports, or clubs, which require them to practice skills to make improvements. We want to help our students make this same connection regarding the importance of academic practice. Practice allows us to become better readers, scientists, and mathematicians. Practice also allows our students to receive the coaching needed to improve their academics. Student work is analyzed by teachers to determine growth and improvement towards mastery of a specific skill or content. So, if a student chooses to not do an assignment, not only are they missing an opportunity to practice a skill and receive feedback, they also miss an opportunity to display mastery of a standard.



Students will still receive behavioral consequences when they choose not to complete academic practice. These consequences (called "Pink Slips") are outlined on pages 7 and 8 of the student handbook. We will continue to reinforce with our students the importance of positive work habits. Just as an NFL team would never expect to win the Super Bowl without hours upon hours of practice, students need the academic practice that prepares them for success.
