The wait is over! The moment you've been eagerly anticipating has finally arrived! The Camp Photos from this year are now ready for your viewing pleasure!

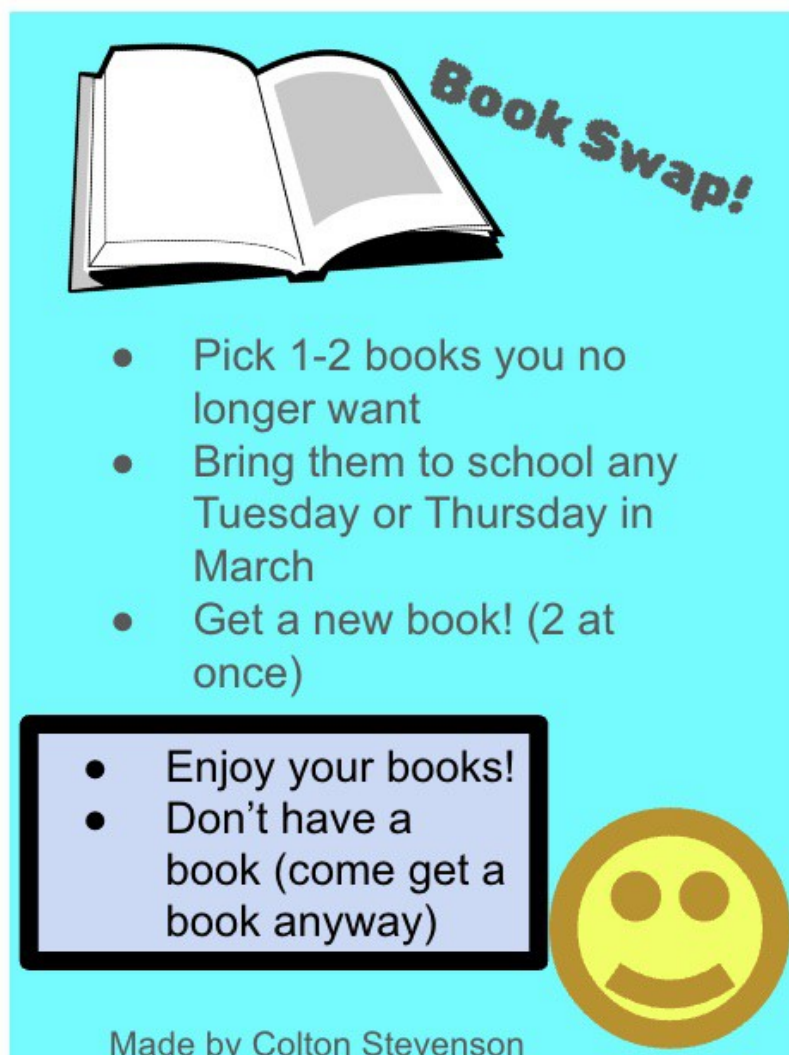
