

Having Fun on Pi Day

The sixth grade students of Eisenhower Intermediate were given the challenge to memorize as many digits of Pi as possible. On March 7th, any student who could recite the first 50 digits of Pi qualified for the finals. There were 14 students who made it past the first round. On Thursday, March 14th, the students got their opportunity to recite as many digits of Pi as they could. All of the students did a great job, with the top three students earning certificates as well as the top student earning a plaque. The top student was Ellie Nowaczyk who recited 125 digits of Pi, Carson Phillips came in second with 114 digits of Pi, and Alaina Simok came in third with 108 digits of Pi. 


