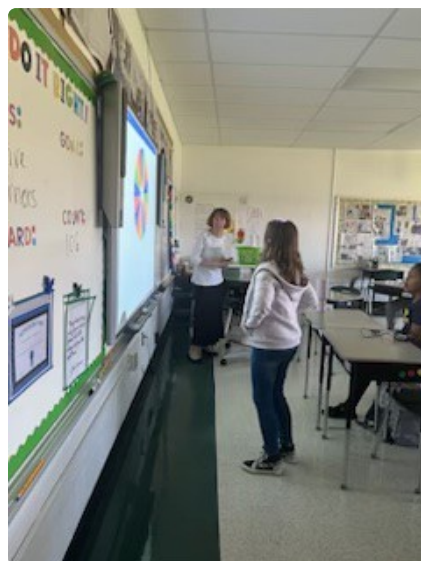

Notes from Nurse Sagrero!

Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s) of 6th Grade Students:

The State of Ohio requires all incoming **7th graders** to have **1 Meningococcal vaccine and the TDap booster in order to attend school in the Fall of 2024**. If you are unsure of your student's vaccination status please consult with his/her healthcare provider to see if your child needs these immunizations. These immunizations are also available at the **Nationwide Children's Hospital-Toledo at OCS 419-696-5533 or Lucas County Shots for Tots N' Teens**.



If your student has already received these vaccines and are up-to-date, please provide an updated copy of your student's vaccination record to Nurse Ashley at Eisenhower. You may also provide a copy to Nurse Kristi at Fassett during 7th grade orientation in **August 2024**. Student will not be permitted to start 7th grade without providing proof of vaccination. . If you have any questions or concerns regarding your student please call Nurse Ashley at 419-836-8498.

1. Child's Paper Shot Record (*electronic copies not accepted*)
2. Child's Insurance Card (*if they have insurance*)
3. Parent's ID
