Attendance (Reporting Absences): under remote learning, if your student misses school due to illness, please continue to use our Attendance Hotline at 419.697.9911. A medical note is still required for an excused absence.

Attendance Policy Under Remote and Hybrid Learning Plan:

- Attendance is taken every day, whether LIVE or SAT period, and is not be based on earned grade(s).
- For a LIVE period:
 - If a student logs in any time during the session, is marked present.
 - If a student does not log-in during the LIVE session, the student is marked absent.
 - If a student misses a LIVE period for an excused reason, he/she will have the opportunity to be marked present, by completing missed work during the same week.
 - If a student does not complete the assignment(s) during the same week, he/she will remain as absent for the given LIVE period.
- For a SAT period:
 - Attendance is based on completion of the assignment (daily assignment in Schoology) and/or if a teacher requests a student to attend SAT. All teachers will provide a daily assignment in Schoology, Monday through Friday.
 - If a student completes the assignment, he/she will remain marked as present.
 - If a student does not complete the assignment(s), he/she will be marked as absent.
