NEW INFORMATION – SECOND SEMESTER REMINDERS:

Calendar:

- **Monday, January 4th:** Staff Work Day – students do not have school.
- **Tuesday, January 5 - Friday, January 8th:** Remote Instruction for all Fassett students.
- **Monday, January 11th:** beginning of Hybrid Instruction for all Fassett students.

Fassett Remote Learning Plan/Schedule: all Fassett students will continue to follow the Remote Learning Plan/Schedule from Tuesday, January 5th through Friday, January 8th. Copies of schedules for 7th and 8th graders, based on morning or afternoon Language Arts/Math blocks, are attached. Students are expected to log-in live to each period, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.

Hybrid Instruction: Hybrid Instruction will begin on Monday, January 11th. Students whose last name begins with A-K will attend Fassett in-person on Monday and Thursday, while students whose last name begins with L-Z will attend in-person on Tuesday and Friday. On the days a student is not attending in-person, Zoom lessons will not take place; teachers will continue to post assignments and learning materials on Schoology. Students should be prepared to continue with assignments and learning via Schoology on days they are not in-person.

Student Assistance Time (SAT): students should continue to use SAT time on Wednesdays to seek help, if needed, from their teacher(s). Teachers will be available during SAT on Wednesday to provide assistance for students. If a teacher or teachers request a student meeting during SAT, attendance is required.

All activities will continue to follow the protocols established by the Lucas County Health Department, Ohio Department of Health, Ohio High School Athletic Association, and the Oregon City Schools once activities are allowed to resume.
