College Credit Plus (CCP) Informational Meeting: is your son or daughter interested in participating in the College Credit Plus program for the 2021-22 school year? If the answer is yes, please plan to attend the virtual meeting on Wednesday, February 10, beginning at 6:00 pm. This meeting will cover a variety of topics including the application process, eligibility, pros/cons of CCP and much more. In order for your child to participate in CCP during the 21-22 school year, the parent must "attend" this meeting AND submit the Intent to Participate Form to your child's counselor before May 1, 2021. A link to this meeting will be emailed to all parents on Monday, February 8. If the student is currently enrolled in CCP courses, attendance at this meeting is not necessary. Counselor Scheduling Appointments for 8th Graders: scheduling for Clay High School begins Monday, February 1st. 8th grade students will meet with Mr. Maletich to select course requests for Clay. Students will choose; (1) Language Arts, (1) Math, (1) Science and (1) Social Studies class. They will also have (3) periods for electives.
