Counselor Scheduling Appointments for 8th Graders: scheduling for Clay High School began Monday, February 1st. 8th grade students are meeting with Mr. Maletich to select course requests for Clay. Students will choose; (1) Language Arts, (1) Math, (1) Science and (1) Social Studies class. They will also have (3) periods for electives. Selections will be based on a student's current courses and grades as well as teacher recommendations. After the Course Request sheets are filled out they will be sent home for a Parent Approval Signature. The scheduling times will be emailed to students and posted in 8th grade hall.
