If a student does not complete his/her academic practice, his/her parent/guardian will be contacted, and provided the option to stay after school for the AP program. If the student completes his/her academic practice during the AP program, he/she will receive credit for the work. **The AP program takes place in the library, after school, until 3:40 p.m., Monday through Friday.** Students must arrange for a ride home from the AP program.
