Welcome back to the 2020-2021 school year! We hope that you and your family had a wonderful summer break!

We know that it is critical for teachers and families to develop a positive relationship in any educational scenario. With starting the year off remotely, this can be a bit challenging. To help establish a positive relationship between teachers and families, please expect a phone call from your child's classroom teacher soon. The teacher will be calling to set-up an in person 45 minute appointment with one parent, your child, and the teacher between the dates of August 24-27.

During this appointment, you will meet the teacher, be provided your child's learning materials (including ChromeBooks), and have time to ask questions regarding the remote learning plan. In addition, there will be an opportunity for your child to be assessed per the set grade level requirements. All social distancing guidelines will be followed. The following social distancing guidelines will be in place upon your arrival to the appointment.

- One parent (guardian) and one student per appointment.
- Please arrive at your scheduled appointment on time, and observe the 6 feet social distancing guidelines when waiting to enter the building.
- If the health of a parent (guardian) and or student is in question, please contact the teacher immediately to make other arrangements for the appointment.
- Everyone entering the building must be wearing a mask while in the building. If you do not have a mask, a mask will be provided for you.
- Everyone will be required to use hand sanitizer upon entrance to the building.
- Everyone will be required to have a temperature check upon entering the building.
- Parent (guardian) and student will be directed straight to the classroom. No one is to wander the building during appointment times.
- After all appointments, the parent (guardian) and student will exit the building immediately.

If you have not arranged to pick up your child's supplies and misc items that were left in March, you can pick that up on the tables in the main hallway. These are arranged by the student's **teacher from last year**.

We hope that our teacher "Meet and Greet" will be a positive kick-off. Again, we are looking forward to another great school year!
