

October Discipline vs Default behavior

Above the line behavior is making a choice to do the right thing. Default behavior is making a choice that is below the line.

Example: If a student takes a students hat at recess and passes it around. Another student has a choice of doing the right thing and giving the hat back to the student or making the wrong choice of continuing passing the hat around.


