

Second Grade Parents/Guardians,

Oregon City School second graders have been chosen to be part of the Eastern Community Branch YMCA "Safety Around Water" program. This program has been made possible with the partnership between the Oregon City Schools and the Eastern Community YMCA with financial assistance from a Y-USA grant and the Oregon Schools Foundation.

What Is Safety Around Water (SAW)?

SAW is composed of swim lessons that reduce the risk of drowning by giving children confidence in and around water. The goal of the program is to teach children to swim, float swim, tread, and exit water.

During this program, all students will be transported to the YMCA during the school day for four swim lessons. The YMCA will provide 2-3 instructors during the swim class to teach swimming and to ensure the safety of all students. Each second grade class will go independent of the other classes. The schedule will be as follows:

Mrs. Kowalski– 8/31,9/7,9/14 Mrs. Munger–9/21,9/28,10/5 Mrs. Schroeder–10/12,10/19,10/26 Mrs. O'Connor–11/3,11/10/11/17

On the days of your child's scheduled swim dates, please have them wear a swimsuit under their clothing. You will want to send a towel and underwear for your child to change into after the swim lessons are over. Goggles are optional. If you choose to send goggles, the goggles cannot cover the nose area and they must be properly adjusted before sending. It is also recommended that girls tie their hair back before getting in the pool. Students will then wear the clothing that they wore to school for the remainder of the day. Students will place their wet clothing and towel in a bag and that bag will come home in your child's bookbag. Parents are permitted to watch swim lessons from the lobby viewing area.

Please complete the permission slip below indicating if you'd like your child to participate in the "Safety Around Water" program and return it to your child's teacher. Regardless, all students will go to the YMCA at their class's designated time. If you do not wish your child to participate in the swim lessons, he/she will be assigned to the supervised gym area at the YMCA. You may contact the school with any questions regarding this program. We hope to make this a great learning opportunity for all!

Physical Education

Dear Parent and/or Guardian.

My name is Jeremiah Przybylski and I will be your child/children's PE teacher this year. This is my 24^{th} year teaching in the Oregon school system and my 16^{th} here at Starr. I would like to take this opportunity to give you a little information about our P.E. program and to let you know what will be expected of your child/children.

Program Goal:

Throughout the year the students will be provided a wide variety of experiences designed to promote healthy physical and social development. It is my goal to develop each child's physical skills and to give them a general appreciation for movement and exercise so that they will leave with the tools necessary to lead a physically active lifestyle.

Dress:

Students should be dressed comfortably and be wearing tennis shoes in order to participate safely in our PE activities. Belts should be worn with loose fitting pants and shorts or tights should be worn under dresses or skirts. Students may not be permitted to participate without appropriate attire.

Instruction:

Grades K-2 will focus mainly on the development of basic movement, skill, and wellness concepts, as well as some low-level team and group activity. Students will practice a variety of ways to travel, change direction and speed, and different ways to balance, jump, and land. They will practice basic skills such as kicking, striking, throwing, catching, and tumbling, and they will be introduced to a few basic fitness concepts. Traits such as a positive attitude, strong work ethic, and good sportsmanship will also be reinforced daily.

Grades 3-5 will spend less time on basic skill development and more time putting these skills to practice through sports and other group activities. These students will also spend more time becoming familiar with fitness concepts and how to apply them.

Discipline

In order to maintain an environment that is safe and conducive to learning, students breaking the class rules and/or causing a disruption will be issued a discipline referral slip and/or receive negative Dojo points. Students may also be asked to take a 5-minute break from the class activity.

Assessment:

Students will receive grades based on the extent to which they meet the state standards for physical education. Activity observation, skill testing, and written assignments will all be used in the assessment process. Like music, PE grades will be issued after the 2nd and 4th quarters and will be based on a 3-point scale. Kindergartners do not receive a grade in PE. Visit education.ohio.gov to view the state standards for physical education.


