**TEMPORARY RESIDENCY FORM**  
**APPLICATION FOR ATTENDANCE**

According to Ohio's School Attendance Law (O.R.C. 3313.64), a student can only attend school tuition free in the district where his/her, "biological-custodial parent" resides.

Residence is defined as:

"(1986) 'Residence,' within the meaning of RC 3313.64, must be a place where important family activity takes place during significant parts of each day: a place where the family eats, sleeps, works, relaxes, plays. It must be a place, in short, which can be called a 'home.' Kenton Bd. Of Edn. V. Day, 30 OMisc2d 25, 30 OBR 289, 506 NE2d 1239 (CP)."

In view of your co-habitation with another resident of the Oregon City School District; and as you have no, "legal residence of your own," Oregon City Schools is required to verify your residency. ***This application must be filled out completely and returned along with 2 proofs of residency from both parties.***

**NOTE: RESIDENCY IS OFTEN VERIFIED THROUGH THE DISTRICT'S RESIDENCY/REGISTRATION DEPARTMENT IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY. PROOF OF RESIDENCY MAY BE REQUESTED PERIODICALLY.**

**THIS APPLICATION MUST BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED IN FRONT OF A NOTARY PUBLIC.**

According to Ohio Tuition Law, the resident of the school district who permits a non-resident student to reside with them, can be held responsible for paying all tuition due, during the time the student resides in their home. For the 2010/11 school year, this amount is approximately \$5,635.25/student/year.

**It is understood that fraudulent reporting of residency for school attendance purposes is a violation of State Law and could result in prosecution of ALL related parties, in a court of law. Further, as the resident of the Oregon City School District, I understand I can be held personally liable for any and all tuition obligations for all days of fraudulent attendance left unpaid by the custodial biological parent.**
